July Jamboree

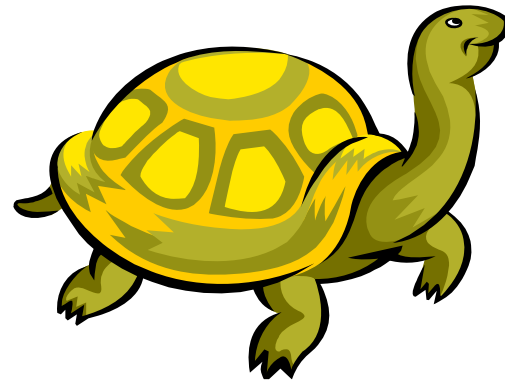
Friday-Sunday, July 3-5
